

BBI Uniform

- **Students are required to present themselves in a clean and tidy manner.**
- The school uniform should be worn with pride. Uniform options are available from a local business, John Russell Schoolwear in Howick, or our second-hand uniform shop.
- P.E. uniform should be worn when engaged in physical activity for health & hygiene.
- Students should change for P.E. and sport before school, or during break times.
- Covered footwear is to be worn to Specialist programmes.
- P.E. tops are not to be worn under formal school uniform.
- Students are to wear *either* formal or P.E. uniform - not a combination of both.
- Students are required to have a note from home should they not be in correct uniform.
- All students must arrive at school in formal uniform. The only exception to this is if they are involved in a sports competition.
- Approved safety helmets must be worn at all times when riding to and from school.
- Students who are involved in P.E. for the final session of the day may leave in P.E. uniform provided sports shoes are worn.

P.E./Sports Uniform

- May be worn to school on Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday - i.e. when we have school-wide fitness.
- Blue regulation shorts/shirt. This is able to be purchased either from John Russell Schoolwear or our second-hand uniform shop (stock and sizes can vary).
- Sports shoes and socks to be worn.
- P.E. uniforms can only be worn to school if students are involved in a sports competition or a before-school training event is scheduled.
- Sports 'hoody' may be worn with P.E. uniform only.
- Plain navy blue cap or bucket hat option to be worn between Labour Weekend and Easter.

Footwear

- Black shoes (plain style) worn with long black socks or white ankle socks.
- Black sandals may be worn.
- Sports shoes with white sport socks with P.E. uniform.

Jackets/Blazer

- An optional BBI jacket may be purchased from John Russell Schoolwear in Howick.
- This jacket can be worn to and from school and outside at interval and lunchtimes. Students representing the school in activities may have a school jacket/tracksuit on loan for that event. This is borrowed from the school and the student is responsible for returning this in good condition.

- An optional blazer is available. This can be worn with the school uniform.

Makeup

- Students are not permitted to wear makeup of any kind to school.
- Nail polish, if worn, should be colourless.

Jewellery

- Only a wristwatch and plain ring (signet ring) may be worn.
- Students with pierced ears may wear one small plain stud in each ear lobe (silver, gold or small stone off BBI colours).

Hair

- Long hair (touching collar) must be tied up.
- Black, white or school coloured hair ties.
- Inappropriate haircuts and colours will be discouraged. Parents will be notified if this is a concern.

Non-uniform clothing (formally known as Mufti)

- Must be appropriate for the school environment, e.g. tops should cover midriff.
