

BBI Uniforms

- **Students are required to present themselves in a clean and tidy manner at all times.**
- The school uniform should be worn correctly at all times. Uniform options are available from a local business, John Russell Schoolwear.
- P.E. uniform should be worn for the time block when appropriate. Students should not be in P.E. uniform all day. P.E. uniform must be worn when playing on the fields, turf and playground during lunchtimes unless a complete change of clothes is required (e.g. Rugby).
- Students should change for P.E. and sports during interval breaktimes and not during class time.
- Covered footwear is to be worn to Specialist programmes.
- P.E. Tee shirts are not to be worn under the school uniform.
- Students are to wear either formal or P.E. uniform – not a combination of both.
- Students are required to have a note from home should they not be in correct uniform.
- All students must arrive at the school in formal uniform, unless involved in BBI Sports before 8.40am(see below).
- Safety approved helmets must be worn at all times when riding to and from school or on any school-related activity.
- Students who were involved in sport / P.E. for the final session of the day may leave in P.E. uniform providing sports shoes with sports socks are worn.
- The school provides a second hand uniform option.

P.E. / Sports Uniform

- Blue sports shorts of regulation style.
- Regulation blue shirt with school logo.
- Bare feet or appropriate sports shoes and white socks.
- P.E. uniform can only be worn to school if a 'before school' training is scheduled, or students are representing BBI in a sporting event.
- The named, optional BBI sports hoody may be worn with P.E. uniform only.
- Plain navy blue cap / school cap or bucket hat should be worn between Labour Weekend and Easter.

Footwear

- Black shoes plain style (low heels) can be worn with black long socks or white ankle socks.
- Black sandals roman-type or rugged sharks style can be worn.
- Sports shoes and white sport socks are encouraged.

Jackets / Blazer

- An optional BBI jacket may be purchased from John Russell Schoolwear.
- The BBI jacket may be worn to and from school and outside at interval and lunch times. Students representing the school in activities may have a school jacket/tracksuit on loan for that event. This is borrowed from the school and the student is responsible for returning this in good condition.
- An optional blazer is available from John Russell Schoolwear. This can be worn with the school uniform.

Makeup

- Students are not permitted to wear makeup of any kind to school.
- Nail polish, if worn, should be colourless.

Jewellery

- Only a wristwatch and plain ring (such as a signet ring) may be worn.
- Students with pierced ears may wear one small plain stud in each ear lobe. (silver, gold or a small stone of BBI colour)

Hair

- Long hair (touching collar) must be tied up.
- Black, white or school-coloured hair ties.
- Inappropriate haircuts and colours will be discouraged. Parents will be notified if this is of concern.

Muffi clothing

- Appropriate for the school environment eg. tops should cover midriff
