Uniforms

- Students are required to present themselves in a clean and tidy manner at all times.
- The school uniform should be worn correctly at all times.
- P.E. gear should be worn for the time block when appropriate. Students should not be in P.E. gear all day. P.E. gear must be worn when playing on the fields, turf and playground during lunchtimes unless a complete change of clothes is required (e.g. Rugby).
- Students should change for P.E. and sports during interval periods and not during class time.
- Covered footwear is to be worn to Specialist programmes when required.
- P.E. Tee shirts are not to be worn under the school uniform.
- Students are to wear either school or sports uniform not a combination of both.
- Students are required to have a note from home should they not be in correct uniform.
- All students must arrive at the school in full school uniform, unless competing in Sport before 8.40am.
- Safety approved helmets must be worn at all times when riding to and from school or on any school related business.
- Students who were involved in sport / PE for the final session of the day may leave in PE Gear. Shoes must be worn.

Girls

- Blue check pleat skirt in regulation material and style (length no shorter than 4-5 cms above the knee).
- > Blue shirt (long or short sleeves) in regulation material and style.
- Unisex uniform trousers.
- Black leather lace up or closed "T-bar strap" leather "school" shoes (low heels) with short white socks or in summer Roman or similar type black sandals.
- > In winter, navy blue tights may be worn, with black shoes only.
- > Blue V neck jersey with school badge.
- Blue, black or white hair tie plain clips. Hair longer than collar length must be tied back.
- > Regulation style sun hat (compulsory from Labour weekend to Easter).

Boys

- Dark navy regulation blue shorts.
- Blue shirt (long or short sleeves) in regulation material and style (worn tucked in).
- Unisex uniform trousers.
- Black leather lace up "school" shoes with black socks and garters at knee height, or in summer Roman or similar type black sandals.
- > Blue V neck jersey with school badge.
- Regulation style sun hat (compulsory from Labour weekend to Easter).

> Hair longer than collar length must be tied back.

P.E. / Sports

- Blue sports shorts of regulation style.
- Regulation blue shirt with school logo.
- > Bare feet or appropriate sports shoes and white socks.
- P.E. uniform can only be worn to school if a 'before school' practice is on, or students will be competing in a sporting event.
- > The named BBI sports Hoody is optional to be worn with P.E. uniform only.

Jackets / Blazer

- The BBI jacket is optional and may be purchased from John Russell Schoolwear.
- The BBI jacket may be worn to and from school and outside at interval and lunch time. Students representing the school in activities may have a school jacket/tracksuit on loan for that event. This is borrowed from the school and the student is responsible for returning this in good condition to the school.
- An optional blazer is available for students. This can be worn with the school uniform.

Makeup

Students are not permitted to wear makeup of any kind to school. Nail polish, if worn, should be colourless.

Jewellery

- Only a wristwatch and plain ring (such as a signet ring) may be worn. Students with pierced ears may wear one small plain stud in each ear lobe.
- All aspects of the uniform should represent the culture of the school and be uniform safe for all.

Hair

- > Long hair (touching collar) must be tied up.
- Inappropriate haircuts and colours will be discouraged. Parents will be notified if this is of concern.
